- sign a pledge to adhere to the **Principles of Ethics** of this Association,
- be members in good standing of the ADA if permanent residence is in the United States or one of its possessions. Full-time faculty members are exempt from this requirement.

#### Dues Additional requirements are listed below

**\$793 ACTIVE MEMBERS** must have successfully completed the full curriculum of an accredited orthodontic program\* or successfully passed The Royal College of Dentists of Canada's requirements for practice in Canada. \$793 is the cost for the AAO portion only. Please call for the total amount of your dues which may also include constituent and/or component dues. Canadians receive a 20% discount. Recent graduates and full-time educators may be eligible for additional discounts.

**\$300 SERVICE MEMBERS** must have successfully completed the full curriculum of an accredited orthodontic program.\* Service members must also be a military or civilian full-time employee of the United States or Canadian government.

**\$30 STUDENT MEMBERS** must be accepted and/or enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited orthodontic program or have completed the full curriculum of an accredited orthodontic program\* and be enrolled as a full-time student in an advanced educational program at an accredited educational institution or have completed an orthodontic program outside of the U.S. or Canada and be enrolled as a full-time student in an advanced educational program at an accredited educational institution OR be engaged full-time in formal fellowship training. Student membership will automatically terminate upon graduation or upon termination of status as a student in an orthodontic program without satisfactory completion.

**\$30 INTERNATIONAL STUDENT MEMBERS** must be accepted and/or enrolled as a full-time student in an orthodontic program outside of the U.S. and Canada and be a student member in good standing of the World Federation of Orthodontists. **(first year is FREE)** International student membership will automatically terminate upon graduation or upon termination of status as a student in an orthodontic program without satisfactory completion.

**\$396.50 INTERNATIONAL MEMBERS** must have successfully completed the full curriculum of an accredited orthodontic program\* OR be a Fellow (member) in good standing of the World Federation of Orthodontists (WFO). An international member must be engaged in the practice of orthodontics or employed as a university instructor in orthodontics outside the territorial jurisdictions of the United States and Canada.

**\$396.50 ACADEMIC MEMBERS** (foreign-trained) must have successfully completed the full curriculum of an orthodontic program outside the U.S. and Canada and must be employed full time (at least 4 days per week teaching or research) in an orthodontic program or dental school accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the American Dental Association. Employment must be certified annually by the dean of the dental school. Annual dues are 50% or 25% of full active member dues. Price listed is the cost for the AAO portion only. Please call for the total amount of your dues which may also include constituent and/or component dues.

\* "Accredited orthodontic program," as used above means those advanced specialty education programs in orthodontics that are accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the American Dental Association or the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada.
